**PLEASE USE PAPER BAGS ONLY,  
IF NOT, MUNICIPALITIES WILL REFUSED THEM**

## 5 OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE TO COMPOST YOUR DEAD LEAVES :

1- **PRACTICE «LEAFCYCLING»** by mulching them with the lawnmower and leaving them to breakdown on your lawn.

2- **DROP-OFF YOUR DEAD LEAVES, FREE OF CHARGE, DURING WEEK DAYS THROUGHOUT THE FALL**, at the RIEDSBM's composting platform, located at 2500, St. Joseph Road in Cowansville (450 263-2351).

**USE PAPER BAGS ONLY** (leaves in bulk are accepted)

3- **DROP-OFF YOUR DEAD LEAVES, FREE OF CHARGE, AT THE ECOCENTRES, ONLY ON THE FOLLOWING SATURDAYS** **USE PAPER BAGS ONLY** (leaves in bulk are accepted)
