Do I continue composting during the winter?

Of course, you do! During the winter, managing organic materials is in fact easier since the cold weather helps by freezing them. Plus, there are no more odours!

But what if organic materials stick to the bottom of the bin?

To avoid having organic materials freeze and stick to the bottom of your bin during winter time.

 Place a big paper bag or several layers of newspaper or cardboard in the bottom.

Remember, because it's winter, there are no odours. So, it won't be a problem if your bin isn't emptied completely. It's also big enough to contain the equivalent of several weeks of organic materials.

The bottom line is that it's important to keep up your good composting habits by putting all your organic waste in your brown bin. Even during the winter, it's possible to produce a good quality compost, it's all up to you!
