Reopening of all Québec schools



→ 100% of students back in class

- Closed groups and standard student-teacher ratios up to Secondary III
- Secondary IV and V:

Option 1

closed groups and standard student-teacher ratios

Option 2

possibility of modifying schedules and reducing time at school to a minimum of 50% to allow optional courses to continue

→ Support offered to students experiencing difficulties or who have specific needs

→ Implementation of health guidelines from a caring perspective

- Increased hygiene measures and clear guidelines
- Stable subgroups of six or fewer students each
- Physical distancing of 1 metre between students in different subgroups and of 2 metres between students and staff
- Movement of staff between classes of students
- Physical distancing of 1 metre on school buses

→ Specific mechanisms for vocational training and adult general education

- Hybrid training: possibility of in-person or distance learning, depending on the circumstances
- Physical distancing of 1.5 metres between students in classes
- Physical distancing of 2 metres between people in laboratories and common areas

NEW!

→ Implementing an emergency protocol to address any eventuality

- Each service centre must develop an emergency protocol allowing it to rapidly transition to quality distance education, if necessary.
- This scenario may be adjusted depending on the health situation at the end of the summer.

→ Maximum in-person student attendance

- Students experiencing difficulties and new students will benefit from priority access to in-person classes and on-site pedagogical support
- Hybrid teaching for everyone: part in-person learning and part distance learning, but always well-supported
- Emphasis on maintaining a rich and stimulating student life

→ Increased support to encourage perseverance and success

- Access to all campus staff to better support students
- Special measures for students with specific needs

→ Measures targeted to ensure the safety of students and staff

- Organization of spaces and schedules to allow for the optimum use of classrooms
- Applicable physical distancing rule: 1.5 metres (16 years and older)
- Implementation of strict hygiene measures
- Emergency protocol in case of a second wave, with the main objectives of providing:
 - guidance
 - support for students to persevere and succeed
 - psychosocial support
 - material support
