REOPENING OF RESTAURANTS

ON JUNE 15

Outside Montréal, the MRC de Joliette,
and the ville de L'Épiphanie, where restaurants
can reopen starting from June 22



- > Indoor dining rooms
- > Terraces and indoor dining rooms can only be used for food service
- Customers must remain 2 metres apart (except the occupants of the same residence) or physical barriers must limit contacts
- Compliance with hygiene measures: handwashing and wearing a mask
- Limitation of self-service areas such as buffets, salad bars and soda fountains
- An establishment cannot be reorganized during the evening to offer activities specific to nightclubs such as a dance floor, musical performances, and so on
- Nightclubs and bars that do not serve food must remain closed for the time being

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NEW DIRECTIVES
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INDOOR GATHERINGS IN PRIVATE RESIDENCES

WILL AGAIN BE ALLOWED STARTING

FROM JUNE 15

Outside Montréal, the MRC de Joliette, and the ville de L'Épiphanie, where such gatherings can take place starting from June 22

- > A maximum of 10 people from three separate households
- > All health recommendations applicable to gatherings, especially minimum physical distancing of 2 metres, must be observed
- > Buffet-style meals are to be avoided
- > At-risk individuals, especially those 70 years of age or over, should avoid participating in such gatherings
- > To reduce the risk of transmission, identify the glasses and provide separate dishes for each household



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
