## \$753-MILLION TOURISM ECONOMIC RECOVERY PLAN

**\$446 million** Help tourism enterprises cover their fixed costs and plan the coming months

**\$200 million** Support investments in business tourism in the hotel sector

**\$48 million** Support the development of tourist attractions

**\$25 million** Support projects to develop tourism offerings and regional tourism enterprises

**\$20 million** Encourage the consumption of Québec tourism products and foster the rebound in tourism

**\$14 million** Ensure that hotels and bed and breakfast establishments have more cash resources by granting a subsidy equivalent to the amount of the accommodation tax that they paid in the first quarter of 2020
