Maximum alert in several regions of Québec

NEW MEASURES IN FORCE FOR THE FESTIVE SEASON AND UP TO AND INCLUDING JANUARY 10, 2021

Closing of non-priority commercial enterprises

In force from December 25, 2020 up to and including January 10, 2021



- Big-box stores may only sell products generally sold in priority commercial enterprises.

Mandatory teleworking in offices

In force from December 17, 2020 up to and including January 10, 2021



- Except for jobs where private- or public-sector employers deem the employees' physical presence necessary

Closing of elementary and secondary schools

From December 17, 2020 up to and including January 10, 2021



- Distance teaching is maintained, according to the school calendar in force.

Educational and childcare services remain open

- Childcare services will remain open, but parents are asked to keep their children at home as much as possible.
- School childcare services remain open but only for children whose parents have priority jobs, such as healthcare staff.



Outdoor activities are permitted

Starting December 17, 2020

- Groups with a maximum of eight people
- No gatherings are permitted in yards or on private lots



Single individuals and family bubbles

In force from December 17, 2020 up to and including January 10, 2021

- It is possible for single individuals and their children to choose one family bubble and join it for certain activities during the holiday season.
