Regional alert level 4: red

	Facilities with no outbreaks	Residents in isolation and facilities with outbreaks
 Visits	• One (1) informal or family caregiver at a time per 24-hour period	• One (1) informal or family caregiver at a time per 24-hour period
Outings to attend gatherings	Outings to attend gatherings are not allowed**.	Outings to attend gatherings are not allowed.

Regional alert level 3: orange

	Facilities with no outbreaks	Residents in isolation and facilities with outbreaks
 Visits	• Two (2) known informal or family caregivers per 24-hour period	• One (1) informal or family caregiver at a time per 24-hour period
Outings to attend gatherings	Outings to attend gatherings are not allowed**.	Outings to attend gatherings are not allowed.

Informal and family caregivers entering into residential facilities during this period must be especially vigilant and follow the instructions for the general public.

*Depending on what assessment is made of the epidemiological situation, the measures could be extended beyond January 11, 2021.
**However, single people can join another family bubble, provided they only join one bubble and it is always the same one. When they return to the residence, special provisions must be applied so they do not come into contact with other residents.
