**Private  
gatherings**

In force solely from  
December 24 up to and  
including December 27, 2020

- It is possible to participate in private gatherings
- A maximum of 10 people
- Remain 2 metres away from other people
- Individuals who display symptoms, are in isolation or have COVID-19 are prohibited from participating in gatherings
- Office parties are not allowed

These measures are subject to the maintenance of the current epidemiological situation and could be revised depending on how it changes.

### Voluntary confinement

Quebecers are asked to engage in voluntary confinement one week before and one week after the period authorized for private gatherings.

### Schools and educational institutions

### Measures in force for the festive season

#### Elementary schools

- Closed from December 17, 2020 to January 3, 2021
- Distance teaching is maintained according to the school calendar in force

#### Secondary schools

- Closed from December 17, 2020 to January 10, 2021
- Distance teaching is maintained according to the school calendar in force

#### Educational and childcare services

- Childcare services will stay open.
- School childcare services will stay open but only for the children of healthcare, education, and priority services staff.

#### Teleworking



Businesses are asked to resort as much as possible to teleworking and to limit their activities starting from December 17.
